Aztek Airbrushed Tool Box

Supplies:

- Testors' Airbrush & Compressor
- Testors' Opaque Blue & Opaque White Airbrush paint
- Testors' Airbrush Cleaner
- 21" Wide Steel Tool Box
- Stencil Nautical Design Pack (Available at Michael's stores)
- Helvetica letter stencils (Available at Michael's stores)

Steps:

1. Remove stickers from outside of toolbox. You may need to use a solvent or product designed to remove adhesive.



- 2. Thoroughly clean surface of toolbox with glass cleaner. Make sure the surface is dry before painting.
- 3. Use spray glue to lightly spray the back of each stencil. Let the spray glue dry until tacky to the touch.



- 4. Plug in and turn on your air compressor. Hook up your airbrush. Set your compressor to 20-25 PSI. This will help to avoid overspray and applying too much paint at once.
- 5. Pour a small amount of blue paint into your airbrush paint cup.
- 6. Test the paint spray on a piece of scrap paper. Make sure that the spray is consistent and even.
- 7. Spray the stencil, making sure to evenly cover the surface.



- 8. Pour any excess paint back into the bottle and clean out your airbrush. To clean your airbrush, pour some Testors' airbrush cleaning solution into the paint cup and spray until the fluid is clear.
- 9. Carefully remove the stencil once the paint is dry.
- 10. Repeat steps 5-8 with the "DAD'S" stencil using white paint and the star stencil with blue paint.



11. Use paint thinner and a paper towel to remove any over-spray.



12. Completed project.
